 TCPL shall conserve energy and prioritize energy-efficient processes across its business operations, increase the share of energy from renewable sources, and enhance the use of green energy. TCPL shall impart its Employees necessary training on energy conservation measures.

4. **Resources Consumption:**
 TCPL shall take initiatives towards efficient use of natural resources and energy, reduction, and prevention of pollution and increase the optimization of its raw materials.

TCPL shall manage its hazardous and non-hazardous waste in accordance with CPCB or SPCB regulations.

Waste Management and Recycling:

- Recycling programs for packaging materials
- Promotion of reuse and reduction of packaging waste

Engagement with stakeholders, including employees, customers, suppliers, and local communities, to promote environmental awareness and enter into necessary collaboration. Partnership with relevant organizations and authorities to address environmental challenges collectively.

Transparency and Reporting

TCPL agrees to the following:

Documentation of key environmental metrics and goals.

Annual sustainability reports to stakeholders.

Accountability mechanisms to track progress and address areas for improvement.
